From clean and simple wrinkle free logo imprinted table throws through a stepped 30-foot tension fabric display for the Pennsylvania State Parks, which has been a destination for attendees since the 2018 Farm Show. Most recently in 2020, we built a 70-foot display for The State Museum and Archives out of pop-up frames with a single tension fabric graphic measuring 40 feet long, and the entire display packs down into eight wheeled canvas bags for easy transport and storage. We also go beyond our state borders supporting the Department of Community and Economic Development with a 800 square foot rental display constructed of lightweight aluminum frames and silicone edge fabric graphics designed to provide a cohesive front for various organizations in our state as they put their best foot forward at the National Plastics Exposition, which happens every 3 years in Orlando

This Invitation to Qualify (ITQ) contract is available for using agencies to procure Custom and Modular Display Systems and services.

On March 19, 2020, the Governor's Office issued a General Purchasing Ban to limit spending of goods or services that are not critical to operations. The agency has determined through its internal approval process that this contract is absolutely critical to operations and the purchase does not violate the Governor's General Purchasing Ban. Additionally, the issuing agency conducted due diligence before issuing a solicitation via positive vendor affirmation and determined that there was sufficient competition due to the prevalence of teleworking allowing a preponderance of suppliers to have access to respond to the solicitation. The phased reopening of counties across the Commonwealth also allowed suppliers to respond to the solicitation in advance of execution of this Contract and work initiation dates. However, this does not alleviate agency responsibility to request approval to issue purchase orders against this Contract.
